



Frederick Banting's sketching trips with members of the Group of Seven, particularly with A.Y. Jackson, are well documented. Burnt Lake, Dorset, Ontario was painted in 1932 while Banting was spending time in the Haliburton area with his friends Dee and Archibald Wells, who later loaned the work to the 1943 Hart House Exhibition. Around 1970, Mrs. Wells gifted this painting to its current owner, who was her physician at that time.

Emily Carr arrived in France in 1910, where the boundaries of modern art were being broken by the Impressionists and Post-Impressionists. Carr declared, "I wanted now to find out what this 'New Art' was about...I saw at once that it made recent conservative painting look flavourless, little, unconvincing." Carr plunged into the crucible of change, embracing this freedom from established rules of art. As usual, Carr found big cities disagreeable, and she soon left Paris for the French countryside, studying with artists Harry Phelan Gibb and Frances Hodgkins, painting en plein air in towns such as Saint-Efflam and Concarneau. She loved Brittany, and her paintings executed there, such as this rich and vital work, reflect her new awareness of light and colour. In Brittany Landscape, the walls of the buildings are washed with light and glow with luscious pastel tones of blue, yellow and pink. Carr contrasts this light-filled palette with the deep greens of vegetation, spindly tree trunks and darker windows and doors. With no one present, the work has the dreamy atmosphere of an afternoon siesta. In 1911, Carr returned to Victoria with a new strength and vision, and held her first exhibition of her French work in Vancouver in 1912.

This fine painting, from the collection of Jan and Judith Zach, has a complete and interesting provenance. Jan Zach (Czech-American, 1914 - 1986) was a highly regarded Oregon sculptor and teacher who trained as a painter in Prague in the 1930s. Judith's hometown was Victoria and the Zachs lived there from 1951 to 1958, renting a home from Carr's sister Alice. The Zachs moved to Eugene, Oregon in 1958, when Jan took a position at the University of Oregon as a professor in the faculty of art. Accompanying this work is a book, Souvenir of Paris by S.L. Bensusan, which is inscribed to Alice Carr from Emily Carr: "on 'last shopping day together in Paris', June 23, 1911."



Algoma was one of the important painting places for the Group of Seven. A.Y. Jackson participated in the second boxcar trip in 1919, accompanying Lawren Harris, J.E.H. MacDonald and Frank Johnston. He was also part of a Group trip to Mongoose Lake, Algoma in 1920, and later returned there in 1924. Jackson continued to visit Algoma in the 1930s - in that decade focussing on the area around La Cloche Hills, and he would later return to Algoma in 1955 and 1956. Algoma was a painter's paradise, with mountains, lakes, forest, swamps, canyons, cliffs, waterfalls, and as in this fine painting, rushing rivers. Jackson depicts the Chippewa surging over strong rock forms with a wall of forest at its edge. Chippewa River, Algoma is lush and painterly, and Jackson's rhythmic brush-strokes loaded with deep green, brown and cream expertly depict the elements of this wild and beautiful place.

The National Gallery of Canada has a 1955 pencil drawing of a similar Chippewa River subject in its collection.

In 1955, A.Y. Jackson left the Studio Building in Toronto, made famous by Jackson and his fellow Group of Seven members. He settled into a newly built studio at Manotick near Ottawa, and also settled into some new migratory sketching patterns. He extensively explored the Gatineau region and often went to the east shore of Lake Superior at Wawa, staying in a cabin he built with friends. From March 18 to April 3 of 1957, he was painting around Ste. Adèle, north of Montreal. Late winter through early spring was a classic sketching time for Jackson, and here he uses his characteristic palette of delicate pastel tones in the softening snow and meltwater in the stream. Graceful curves of bare branches in the trees lining the creek and gently rolling snowbanks and rutted paths bring rhythm to the landscape. The bright red roofs of rural buildings add brightness to the snowy scene and a warm sense of human presence, an intangible feeling so expertly captured by Jackson from his vantage point across the stream.

A.Y. Jackson traveled to Port Radium on Great Bear Lake in the Northwest Territories a number of times: 1938, 1949, 1950, 1951 and 1959. In 1938 Gilbert Labine arranged to fly Jackson from Edmonton to his Eldorado Mine, a uranium mine on Great Bear Lake. Hiking all through the country, with its "thousands more lakes among thousands more hills", Jackson was thrilled by its vast scale. Again in 1949, Jackson was flown to the area on the Eldorado Mine plane, this time joined by the artist Maurice Haycock, who also accompanied Jackson on sketching trips to the area in 1950 and 1959. Jackson liked the tapestry of rough lichen-covered boulders and the distinctive patterns of scrub bush in the open land. He lit up this painting with bright trees that are like candles of colour flickering around the hills, their dance reflected in the calm lake.

The year 1964 was another active one for the peripatetic A.Y. Jackson – in winter he sketched in Quebec's Morin Heights with Edwin Holgate and at Sainte-Agathe with Samuel Borenstein. By late March he had moved on to Lake Clear in Ontario, in July he was at Canoe Lake at Algonquin Park, in autumn in Alaska and the Yukon, and in November Port Arthur in Ontario. In Near Lac Paquin, Quebec, Jackson chose an expansive perspective from the top of the hill above the town across to the hills beyond. Jackson's sure handling of his subject is present everywhere - in the use of the road to lead the viewer's eye through the town, the overcast winter light and the rhythm in the rolling hills. A lifetime of sketching Quebec towns and getting to know its people infused his depictions of Quebec rural life with a feeling of affection, embodied here in the two figures walking down the road and the contrast between winter's cold and the warmth of the houses nestled in the snowy fields.

A.Y. Jackson's first exposure to the North Shore of Lake Superior came at the end of a 1921 Algoma trip. Arthur Lismer, who had accompanied Jackson and Lawren Harris there, had to return to Toronto to resume his teaching duties at the Ontario College of Art, so Jackson and Harris continued on to Schrieber and Rossport, on the shores of Lake Superior. The toughness of the land, its vast, unpopulated expanses and wide skies held endless material. Harris and Jackson returned in the fall of 1922, specifically to the Coldwell region. Here, the conditions were even rougher and the poor weather gave them endlessly overcast skies, cold and rain. This seems, however, to have provided fodder for their experience, and this seminal trip seeded their sketches with the ideas that became many Group of Seven period masterworks; Port Monroe, Lake Superior is one of these. The sombre palette depicts cold, steely skies and a barren, glacially scrubbed land that fully evokes the character of this region.

After moving to his newly built studio at Manotick near Ottawa in 1955, A.Y. Jackson, together with his friends Professor and Mrs. H.U. Ross, bought land on the eastern shore of Lake Superior at Twidale Bay near Wawa, Ontario. A cabin was built on the property, as Jackson planned to travel there and paint, and he began including it in his cycles of sketching trips, along with Georgian Bay and Gatineau. Typical of this area, there is a feeling of open skies and far vistas. Jackson first saw Lake Superior on its north shore while with Lawren Harris in 1921, and the logs on the shore are a reminder of Harris's dramatic vistas that featured weathered stumps and bare trees. The sculpted driftwood, the shore carved into interested shapes and contrasting colours of turquoise and cobalt lake water give this strong painting its visual impact.

While he was still a member of the Group of Seven, Frank Johnston went on sketching trips in northern Ontario with J.E.H. MacDonald, Lawren Harris and A.Y. Jackson, and was well aware of the iconic snow scenes produced by Harris and Jackson. When he left the Group, Johnston continued to explore northern Ontario, often visiting the fishing camp of his friend Jack McCurdy on Onaman Lake in the country around Lake Nipigon. Johnston was undaunted by the cold, and his hardiness was part of the myth that surrounded the Group members, who were unafraid of enduring nature's hard conditions to paint the wilderness. Johnston was known for the sensation of stillness, clarity of light and luminosity of atmosphere in his winter paintings. Winter Arabesque is also a fine example of Johnston's eye for beauty, with its pattern of lacey branches, delicate pastel tones in the snow, brilliant light and blue shadows, and shimmering reflections in the stream.

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Tidal Pools shows Gordon Smith leaving behind the grid system of his 1970s paintings, in which landscape was broken into carefully modulated horizontal planes. His paint was becoming more gestural and his planes of landscape more abstracted – although in Tidal Pools, the elements of land, sky, sea and beach are still apparent. Ian Thom writes, "When asked to characterize his art from 1979 to 1980, Smith commented that his new works were about 'colour, the act of painting, surface sensitivity and space.'" Ever the modernist, Smith has always examined the nature of paint itself as well as his imagery and worked in transformative directions. Through the dissolving suggestions of matter and atmosphere, Smith makes the work about both his gestural brushwork and the delicate atmosphere of the West Coast.

In Pierre L'Allier's view (1991), 'Even if Suzor-Coté had only created this one work, his name would deserve to be featured in any history of Canadian sculpture.'" This work is on a wood base.
